

Eligibility for Ames Little League Baseball If You Have Moved Out Of Town

Provide a photocopy of documents from 3 of the following categories for both your current residence and your former residence. Three utility bills would not meet the requirements; the 3 documents must be from separate categories but all must show your address.

1. Driver's license
2. Voter's registration
3. School records (report cards, etc.) Ames's usually don't have addresses
4. Welfare/child care records
5. Federal records
6. State records
7. Local records
8. Support payment records
9. Homeowner or tenant records
10. Utility bills (gas, electric, sewer, water, phone, mobile phone, heating, waste disposal, etc.)
11. Financial records (loan, credit, investments)
12. Insurance documents
13. Medical records
14. Military records
15. Internet, cable or satellite records
16. Vehicle records

Send all 6 documents to Flynn Ravner (president@ameslittleleaguebaseball.org), who will fill out the appropriate paperwork and send them to the District Administrator. The District Administrator will sign both and keep one for his records and return the other to Flynn.

ALLB retains these records and players will be fully eligible for the extent of their little league career. If the player does not play one year and then wants to play the next, they would not be eligible.
